#### **New Students**

Application and full payment must be received to secure a place in class.

A valid email address is essential to our communication. Please be sure that your email address is clearly printed on the application. Special arrangements can be made if you do not have an email account. New students must submit a Physician's Referral Form with their application. New students will be required to meet with our Program Director to determine class placement.

#### **Returning Students**

Application and full payment must be received to secure a place in class.

A valid email address is essential to our communication. Please be sure that your email address is clearly printed on the application. Special arrangements can be made if you do not have an email account. Returning students must submit a Renewal Application. In addition, students must submit a Physician's Referral Form once every 12 months. Be sure that your referral is up to date.

#### **Clothing and Equipment**

Helmets must be worn when participating in any program activities. Bicycle or other sports helmets are not approved for riding. Helmets can be found online or locally at Tractor Supply. Long pants are required even during hot weather. Shoes or boots with heels are preferred, but not required.

#### Attendance

Make-up classes are only scheduled in the event HOHB must cancel a class due to weather. Please be on time. Advance notice of a planned absence from class is appreciated. Late notice should be called in to (814) 474-5276. Horses without a rider will be put away10 minutes after class starts.
